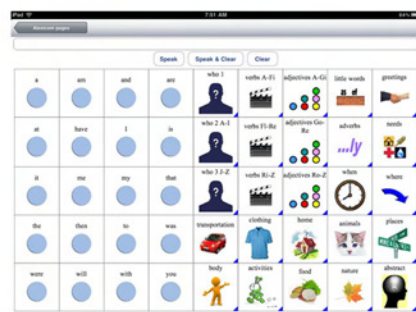
Pic Speechmaker

Speechmaker is a text-based page set intended for people who are literate with a vocabulary intended for teens, young adults, and adults. It includes most core vocabulary necessary to engage in conversation as well as topical vocabulary to make highly specific sentences.

Both of these page sets were created for adults unable to verbally communicate as a result of illness or injury. Each page set contains core words and pre-made phrases.

The structure of the following LanguageMaker page sets are consistent with Brown's Five Stages of Language Development. Beginning with single word utterances, the user may put together simple words, integrate "core" vocabulary, add grammatical markers, and develop syntactical skills to create complete sentences.

Child Pre A/Child Pre B



The Child Pre A/B page sets are for beginning communicators or those with limited discrimination skills. These picture-based pages contain fewer cells, making visual processing and selection easier.

Child Pre A: 2 x 3

Child 1A/Child 1B



Child 1A/1B page sets are for children learning to put two or more words together. At this stage, the communicator begins to label items, indicate location, make comments and ask questions. Both sets include simple prepositions, negation and simple phrases including beginning subject and possessive pronouns (i.e. "I" and "mine").

Child 1A: This set introduces core vocabulary

Child 2



The Child 2 page set contains additional core words so the user can construct novel phrases and ask a variety of questions. Pre-made context phrases (i.e. "I'm hungry") are still available to facilitate initiation of particular topics.

Child 2: The set contains plural, auxiliary and copular verbs (i.e. is/are) and simple conjunctions (i.e. and).

Child Intermediate



Child Intermediate is a picture-based page set which requires a higher level of visual discrimination. The user can construct sentences of greater length and variation facilitating better social communication.
