ISO 9999 Assistive devices for persons with disabilities – classification and terminology:

- Any product (including devices, equipment, instrument, technology and software) especially produced or generally available, for preventing, compensating for, monitoring, relieving or neutralizing impairments, activity limitations and participation restrictions.

4 principals for the Disability Policy in Denmark



- Solidarity
- Compensation
- Sector responsibility
- De-institutionalization

Administration and responsibility of providing assistive devices and services



- Municipality
- Region
- State

- The best and cheapest product

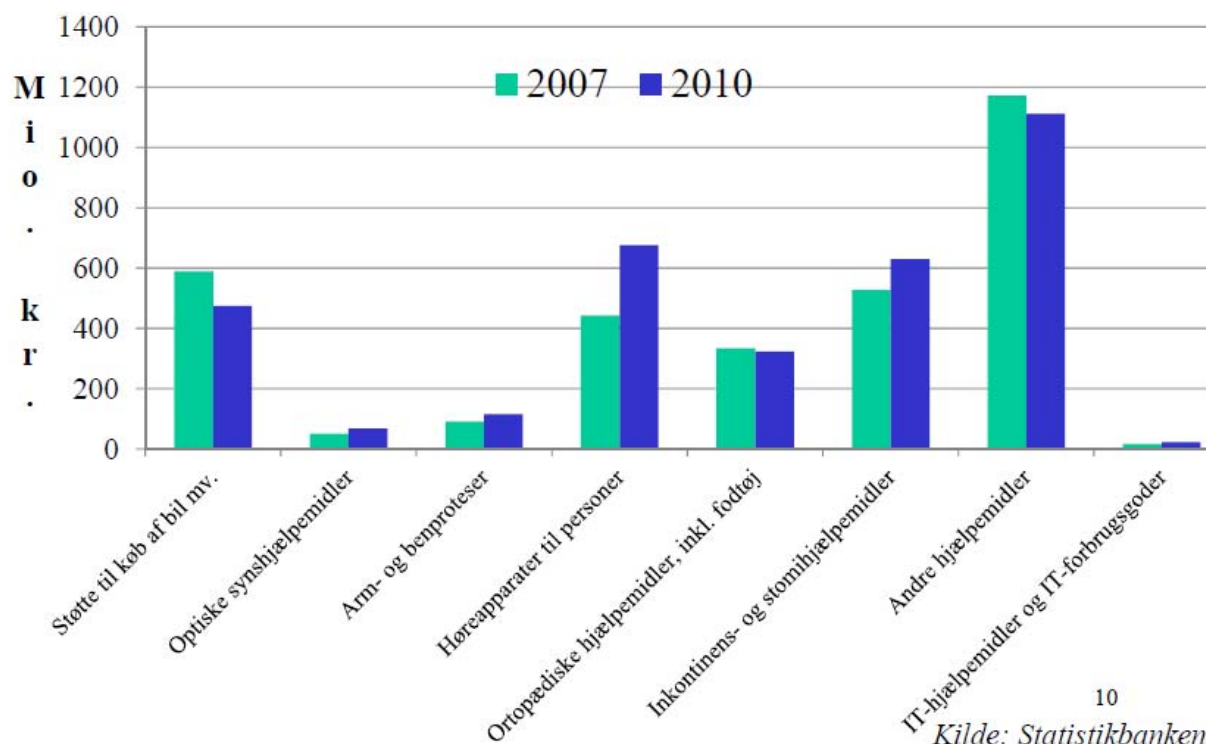
From the users' aspect
