A glance at Sweden and its AT delivery system

- Approx 9,5 million inhabitants
- 20% of the population has a disability
- About 10 % use assistive devices
- 21 county councils (regional authorities)
- 290 municipalities (local authorities)
- Regional and local authorities have the responsibility for the AT provision




Laws and regulations

- County councils and municipalities are obliged to provide people with disabilities with assistive devices - Health and Medical Service Act §3b + §18b
- To support everyday life, for care and treatment
- Every regional authority decides on regulations for assistive devices and fees
- No possibility of making complaints legally when decisions are taken


Division of responsibility

- Municipalities/county councils
 - Primary health care centres
 - Assistive technology centres
- County councils:
 - Hearing centres
 - Low vision centres
 - Habilitation and rehabilitation units
 - Speech therapy clinics
 - Computer resource centres
 - Orthopaedic workshops





The prescription process





Free choice of Assistive Technology

- Practice-oriented pilot study 2007 – 2009, coordinated by SIAT
- The county councils participating were: Kronoberg, Stockholm and Sörmland
- Alternative way for user to get access to assistive technology



Why Free choice of Assistive Technology?


• Aim was to:

- Strengthens the users' participation and influence
- Increase the individual's freedom to choose the assistive device





The Free choise process, voucher



Free choice users

- Almost 50 % were 65 79 years old
- Involvement in the choice of assistive device
- 7 out of 10 thought that usability had increased
- Function, features and accessories are important
- 57 % paid an extra amount to buy a more expensive device
- A few % of all prescriptions were free choice prescriptions


Hearing aids

- 40% of all free choice prescriptions during the first trials
- First time hearing aid users get more benefit from free choice system than ordinary system (IOI-HA).
- Experienced users, no verified difference in satisfaction
- Stockholm and Skåne have implemented free choice, approx 1/3 of Sweden's population
 - Also implemented free choice of caregivers (hearing shops)

- Availability of information about AT
- Find places where you can see & test devices

Personal budget for Assistive Technology

- SIAT got a governmental assignment to propose conditions for running a pilot study with personal budget for assistive technology
- Personal budget is a development of the Free choice project
- Instead of a voucher the user can get money on an account
- No decision for trials yet




Important steps to personal budget

- Rehabilitation plan
- Agreement
- Follow up







Consumer products (& services)

















Alternative telephony - For people with limited hearing/deafness or speech abilities

- Assistive technology
 - Textphones
 - Videophones
 - Total conversation (simultaneous text, video and audio)
- Mainstream technology, e.g. computers, smartphones, pads/tabs with
 - Skype, MSN Messenger, Oovoo, Tango
- Equivalent in function, but different in many ways

SIAT coordinate pilot study

- Swedish Post and Telecom Agency
 - Procures video and text relay services
 - Requires that CT can be used for relay calls
- Seven County Councils are funded for trying out new ways of dealing with AT and mainstream technology for telephony
 - Trying to fulfil user needs by prescribing CT
 - Evaluating whether CT is sufficient
 - Finding out reasonable ways to handle support, instruction etc.
